COVID-19

As required by Transport Canada, front-line representatives will ask all travellers specific questions to conduct a health check prior to travel, as well as conducting a temperature check. Travellers are to have a removable face covering or non-medical mask to cover their mouth and nose to prevent the inadvertent spread of Covid-19. Travellers must wear their masks at all times during the check-in and boarding process, and for the duration of the flight. As well as masks should be worn any time guests are 2 metres or less away from other people, or when directed by Helijet team members.

Helijet is pleased to participate in the Helicopter Association International COVID Clean Pledge and World Travel & Tourism Council's Safe Travels program to meet or exceed any applicable federal, provincial or municipal public health regulations.

In adhering to these programs, Helijet is continuing to monitor and adjust flight schedules, and has increased sanitizing, and physical distancing procedures and protocols including:

- Sanitizing aircraft cabins before each flight, as well as disinfecting high touch areas within the cabin, cockpits and terminals.
- Providing a detailed disinfection regime for all aircraft at the end of every day, to ensure no contaminants remain for passengers who board the aircraft next.
- Frequent deeper cleaning of terminal facilities, washrooms and offices.
- Making hand sanitizer, available and encouraging its use, to all passengers.
- Complimentary food and beverage services at terminals has been changed to offer only grab-and-go pre-packaged food, and discontinuing re-using of glasswear.

Travel Information

All flights operated by Sikorsky S76 helicopter with a capacity of 12 passengers. Schedule is subject to change without notice, visit helijet.com for most up to date flight and fare availability.

Check-in: For all flights at least 20 minutes prior to departure. Failure to check-in, or to change/cancel your flight by 5pm the day prior to travel will result in a no-show / cancellation penalty.

Accessibility: Terminals and aircraft are accessible, preboard seating assistance available upon request. Please advise of any mobility requirements at time of booking. Please visit helijet.com for detailed travel information.

Included with your fare

Generous Baggage Allowance: 2 pieces per person, 50lbs in total, for all fare classes. No cabin baggage, oversize/excess baggage taken on a space available basis, at no added charge.

Free Parking: Free parking is available in a limited number of allocated spots at all terminals, register your vehicle with the check-in agent.

Terminal Amenities: Complimentary wine/beer, specialty coffee, tea, drinks, pre-packaged snacks, grab-n-go snack boxes available. Complimentary daily/weekly newspapers, magazines & WIFI available at all terminals. Work stations available at Victoria and Vancouver Terminals.

Shuttle Van: Complimentary drop-off shuttle van available upon arrival, ask check-in agent for shuttle route limits or if you will need a taxi on arrival. Alternatively, book your own Lyft/Uber or other ride-share to meet you at your destination terminal.

PLUS Kids Fly Free!

Confirmed full fare paying adult passengers may bring one accompanying child, 12 years or under, on the same flights for free.

Terminals

- Victoria Harbour Heliport – 79 Dallas Road, Victoria – between the Odgen Point Cruise Ship Terminal and the Canadian Coast Guard station
- Vancouver Harbour Heliport – 455 West Waterfront Road, Vancouver - near the SeaBus terminal in downtown Vancouver. Accessible by vehicle via the Main or Cordova Street ramps down to Waterfront Road or on foot, with Compass Card, through Waterfront Station/SeaBus Terminal
- Vancouver International Airport (YVR) – 5911 Airport Road, Richmond – south airport helipad, at the corner of Inglis Drive, near the #2 Road Bridge
- Nanaimo Harbour Heliport at the Cruise Ship Welcome Centre – 100 Port Drive, Nanaimo (Port Of Nanaimo Welcome Centre)
